

On October 1<sup>st</sup>, Entrepreneurship at Cornell was recognized for “Exceptional Activities in Entrepreneurship Across Disciplines” by the Global Consortium of Entrepreneurship Centers (GCEC) at the annual conference hosted University of Rochester and Rochester Institute of Technology.

Directors, staff members and faculty from entrepreneurship centers at academic institutions representing 16 countries were among the more than 400 attendees participating in the three-day conference. The GCEC awards – in eight categories - are designed to showcase and celebrate the very best of university entrepreneurship. 92 award applications were received, setting a record number of submissions, for consideration by a panel of GCEC 2016 judges.
