

Tim Barry (CALS '93; Parent '27) is the founder and Managing Director of Red Moose Investments. Red Moose invests in early stage healthtech companies that materially enhance clinical value and lifestyle for beneficiaries of the healthcare system. Previously, Tim was the co-founder, Chair and CEO of VillageMD, retiring from the company in 2024. Under Tim's leadership, VillageMD grew from one clinic and eight physicians to over 800 clinics, 4,000 physicians, and 21,000 employees. A pioneer in value based healthcare delivery, VillageMD was routinely recognized for the quality of care it provided to its millions of patients, and Tim was recognized by Modern Healthcare in 2023 as one of the 100 Most Influential People in U.S. healthcare.

Prior to VillageMD, Mr. Barry served in a number of executive roles across Accretive Health, Universal American, and Blue Shield of California. He currently sits on the Boards of Red Moose portfolio companies and is active in several healthcare nonprofits.

For Cornell, Mr. Barry has served on the Board of Trustees since 2024. He and his wife, Stephanie, have been key supporters of leadership initiatives with the College of Human Ecology, Entrepreneurship At Cornell, and Cornell Athletics.
